

Thank you for enquiring about a school trip to Shortwood Farm.

A typical trip would be as follows: When you arrive we would give the children a safety talk before we start the tour. We would then spend approx 1.5 - 2 hours feeding farm animals, holding small animals such as kittens and guinea pigs, meeting the ponies and donkeys and hand milking the cow.

Lunch could be eaten in either our inside or outside picnic areas. The shop would be open at lunchtime. We realise that spending money can be very time consuming especially with young children, so if required we can set up a £1 stall away from the other things so that children can just choose from there.

After lunch the children can play in the indoor or outdoor play areas before being taken on a walk (or a tractor ride) to the woods to see the badger sett.

Obviously each trip can be tailored to suit the requirements of each school.

The cost is £5 per child, £7 per Adult, with a 10% over all discount for parties of 15 or more. As a high number of adults are required to accompany young children half will be admitted free of charge.
